| Khan Academy | https://www.khanacademy.org/ | This free website requires a parent or teacher to create an account for a child. It offers an almost unlimited number of math practice exercises, organized by topic, with instant feedback and progress data. |
| Learn Zillion | https://learnzillion.com/ | This free website offers an online database of short video lessons aligned to Florida Standards. The videos feature commentary, extra hints, tricks, and a "try-it-yourself" segment to have students practice on their own. You can choose to create a free account or not. |
| Xtra Math | http://xtramath.org/ | This free website requires a parent or teacher to create an account for a child. XtraMath is a collection of free math activities that will help kids with basic fact practice to develop fluency. Kids will practice straightforward arithmetic problems that adapt as they learn. Parents can receive emails updating them on their child's progress. |
| Ten Marks | http://www.tenmarks.com/ | This free website requires a parent or teacher to create an account for a child. A web-based adaptive math program closely aligned to the Florida Standards that offers math practice, enrichment and intervention. |
